OPtHA Spring Spectacular Show Information

WELCOME!

Welcome to the OPtHA Spring Spectacular Show! The OPtHA Board of Directors and the members of the Show Committee have been working for months to make this the best show of the year! Please be sure to read the information in this show premium which includes important details about our show including the Show Office, Mini & Pony Measurement, Show Stalls, RV's, Classes, General Rules, High Point Divisions and Awards.

THE SHOW OFFICE

Office Hours: The show office in the arena building will be open Thursday afternoon by 3PM and then will be open on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday mornings 1 hour prior to the start of the show and close after the last class of the day.

Checking In: Please check in at the show office prior to the start of the show, even if you have a permanent number. Be sure to bring a form of payment when you check in at the show office. If you did not upload all necessary documentation, please bring copies the office can keep. Numbers will not be released without a form of payment & copies of all necessary documentation on file.

Office Fee: All entries will be charged \$10.00 for each horse, to help offset the office cost & supplies.

Class Entries:

All entries must be submitted online at www.oregonpinto.com – no exceptions. Pre Entry deadline is February 28th. A \$25 post entry fee will be added to any exhibitors entered after February 28th, 2024.

Multi-Class Discount: For Pinto (PtHA) Horses -- enter 10 PtHA classes and get the 11th & 12th classes FREE! PtHA Mini/Pony Divisions – enter PtHA 7 classes and get the 8th for FREE!

All Breed Show Entries: Horses entered into All Breed Classes do not need to be registered or show any other documents.

Pinto Breed Show Entries: All horses and riders entered in Pinto point classes at this show must be registered with PtHA. The exhibitor and owner of a Pinto in PtHA classes must be a current member of PtHA. A copy of PtHA registration papers and current PtHA membership card must accompany show entry. **WHEN REGISTERING, EXHIBITORS MUST USE THE NAME LISTED EXACTLY AS IT IS PRINTED ON YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD.** (For example: If your name is listed as Victoria on your membership card, you cannot register for the show as "Vicki" instead.) Failure to use the correct name may result in loss of points with the national office. If showing in PtHA Amateur Classes, a current Amateur Card must be included with entry, a walk- trot card must also be provided for anyone entering walk-trot classes, No exceptions. **PtHA Leases:** Exhibitor must have an approved lease certificate from the PtHA office or complete the new Lease process at the show.

Transfers & Leases can be done at the Show! PtHA Approved Charter shows can now accept At Show Transfers and Leases in the show office. In addition to the Transfer or the Lease form, an AT SHOW FORM must also be completed. There is a \$100 rush fee added to the regular cost of the transfer or lease. When doing a Transfer, you must have the original registration certificate, the transfer form and the AT SHOW FORM. If you have lost the original registration certificate, then you must also complete a DUPLICATE REQUEST FORM. Please make sure everyone has signed the forms where indicated. This will allow you to show on the Transfer or Lease at the show.

Adding/Scratching Classes: All Add/Scratch should be completed online. If you add a class within ten classes of the class, you must also notify the In Gate person. If you decide to add a class and need to do so at the gate, please give the In Gate person your number, name and horse's name. If you want to scratch, you must notify the office at least three classes beforehand. If you don't scratch in time don't show in a class you've entered in, you will be charged for the class.

Exhibitor Numbers: Numbers are assigned; the exhibitor must display the correct number when being judged at all times. You may purchase a permanent number for \$10 for the year from Oregon Pinto Horse Association prior to the show. Western and English exhibitor numbers must be on each side of the saddle pad. In showmanship, bareback equitation and in hand classes, the number must be worn on the exhibitor's back. Driving numbers must be placed on both sides of the cart on the shafts. Halter numbers can be on the back or the right hip of the exhibitor. Failure by the exhibitor to wear the correct number in the visible manner while being judged will result in disqualification.

Refunds: There are no refunds for stall reservations for any reason. Class entries and other fees may be refunded if a doctor's note or veterinarian's note regarding the entered horse is submitted to the office – notes must be submitted within 72 hours of the show. Notes must be presented to the Show Secretary. Failure to show note constitutes forfeiture of entry fees. At the show, show management may, at their discretion, waive the necessity of a Veterinarians' certificate. **ALL REFUNDS WILL BE MAILED AFTER ALL CHECKS HAVE CLEARED THE BANK AFTER THE SHOW.**

Returned Checks: A fee of \$50.00 will be charged on any check returned by the bank for any reason. If full payment plus the \$50.00 return check fee is not paid within 7 business days, PtHA office will be notified and a full suspension from PtHA and all points will be forfeited. NO EXCEPTIONS.

ON SITE PINTO REGISTRATION

You Can Register Your Pinto @ the Show if you want to show in the Pinto Classes.

All Pintos must be registered to show in Pinto Classes. Registrations can be done through the PtHA National Office or at the show. If your horse needs to be registered, please contact the show's Registration Coordinator at the number above to schedule an appointment at a show. MINI/PONY MEASUREMENT

All Minis and Ponies MUST BE measured by an approved PtHA Representative before being eligible to show or they must have a Permanent PtHA Measurement Card or current PtHA Annual Measurement card submitted when entering. Measurement times and location will be posted on the Show Office window. Please try to have measurements scheduled promptly after arrival.

STALLS & HAUL INS

ALL STALLS must be prearranged and paid for in advance. Exhibitors wishing to stall together must indicate this on their Stall Form.

Show Stalls for the duration of the show are \$140 for Thursday at noon-Sunday pm. Bulk shavings are included in the price.

Day Stalls are \$50 for a 24 hour period. Bulk shavings are included in the price. The Stall Chart will be posted on the club's Facebook page on Tuesday night before the show and will be posted in the Show Office window on arrival day.

Refunds: There are no refunds for stall reservations for any reason. No exceptions.

Haul Ins: Haul Ins are \$15 per day. If a horse is entered in the show and does not have a stall, they will be charged a \$15 haul in fee.

Garbage: The Oregon State Fairgrounds provides dumpsters at the front and back of the show barn. If you would like to have a trash can in your aisle, please bring one with you for the show.

CAMPING INFORMATION

Camping Spots must be paid in full online prior to the show. No exceptions.

RV Hook Up Fees: Electric Only Hook Ups are available. The cost is \$30 per night. Please bring a long extension cord with you. Any RV or trailer parked in a marked RV spot will be charged the nightly fee. Please park vehicles in the parking area adjacent to the RV spots. Please pick up your RV ID Tag from the Show Office. Once trailers are emptied, they should be parked away from the barns so that cars and other vehicles can be parked in the parking spots.

Dry Camping: Dry Camping is available for those staying in tents. Dry Camping spots are free. Dry Camping spots are in designated areas only. Please see Show Office or Coordinator Mike Merina for the designated spots available.

Camping Spot Assignments: The RV and Dry Camping Spots will be posted on the club's Facebook Page the Tuesday night before the show.

PARKING

Parking for vehicles is located behind or beside the show horse barn. Once you are done unloading your horse trailer, please move it immediately to your designated camping spot or to the gravel section to the side of the show barn. Do not park in the Livestock Barn.

CLASSES

Classes: Every PtHA class offered herein will be shown and judged in accordance with PtHA rules. A copy of the rulebook can be found in the show office, with the show manager, and at www.ptha.org.

Class Combinations/Cancellations: The Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split any class which does not fill, has no entries or has an excess of entries. Fees will be refunded if class is cancelled.

PtHA and PtHA Solid classes cannot be combined but can run concurrently. Concurrently means they will be run together but ultimately placed as separate classes.

Youth Walk/Trot 10 & Under and 11-18: & Colored/Solid Classes May be Run Concurrently: classes cannot be combined, but can run concurrently together. Concurrently means they will be run together but ultimately placed as separate classes. The PtHA colored division classes may also be run at the same time as the PtHA solid division classes but will also be placed separately.

In Gate: Please check in with the In Gate person as your class approaches. This helps keep classes running smoothly and efficiently. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be at the In Gate prior to their class.

Patterns: Patterns will be available on the OPtHA website www.oregonpinto.com prior to the show. If you would like printed copies, please bring them with you. Patterns will be posted at the show office and at the entrance to the arena.

Class Order: For pattern classes, exhibitors are expected to line up for classes in an efficient and timely fashion.

Gate Holds: If a tack or exhibitor change is necessary, the exhibitor may request a two-minute gate hold. Request must be made to the Show In Gate at least TWO classes prior to when the Gate Hold is needed.

Class Refunds: No refunds for any class that is missed or if the exhibitor is disqualified for any reason.

Coaching: Coaching that is inappropriate or interferes with other exhibitors or judges is prohibited. Management reserves the right to exclude any horse or rider showing objectionable behavior from the show grounds without being held liable for damages or compensation. Management also reserves the right to reject any entry (rider, driver, handler, exhibitor, trainer or coach) it deems advisable in the best interest of the show.

Youth and Amateur Walk/Trot Division exhibitors may not cross-enter into any lope or canter classes at this show.

Youth Driving Classes: A Header is required. All Headers must wear proper attire as listed in the current PtHA Rulebook.

Ideal Pinto Classes Grooms: Grooms must wear proper attire which consists of a long sleeve shirt with collar or a lab coat. Closed toed boots or shoes and long pants are also required. No baseball hats/caps, hooded sweatshirts or short-sleeved shirts are allowed.

Halter Classes

Halter Combinations: If a halter class needs to be combined, it will be combined before the show starts that day. Combinations are first by type and then by sex. **Staging:** The halter classes will be staged in a portion of the arena one class ahead. This holding area will be inside the main arena. Exhibitor must be in the holding area one class prior so they may be checked in.

All Breed Individual Class Awards: All Breed classes offer a ribbon based on the average of the three judges for each class. Exhibitor is responsible for picking up their ribbons each day.

Trail Classes: Any horse entered in an In Hand Trail or ridden Trail class will be charged a \$15 trail course equipment fee. The money raised from this fee will go directly towards the club's trail equipment and materials. The Trail Course will be set up in the end of the warm-up arena as early as possible on Friday through the end of Saturday lunchtime. Please be sure to reset poles or other elements your horse disturbs when navigating the practice trail course.

EXHIBITORS/PARENTS/TRAINERS/VISITORS

Exhibitors: Knowing the rules and regulations as well as the requirements for each class entered is your responsibility.

All Exhibitors/Parents/Trainers/Visitors: Must always show courtesy and good sportsmanship to all show officials and other exhibitors. Any misconduct will result in immediate dismissal from the show and the grounds. All fees will be forfeited.

Misconduct: The decision of the Judges is final in all classes. Nobody may approach a Judge with regards to a decision without first obtaining permission from the Show Manager. The Show Manager may arrange an appointment with the Judge and will notify the person who has a complaint of the time.

Protests: A protest must be in writing, signed and addressed to the Show Manager and received by a member of the Show Committee within twelve hours of the alleged violation and accompanied by a deposit payable to PtHA of \$250.00, which may be forfeited if the protest is sustained. Please see the current PtHA Rulebook for further clarification.

AWARDS

High Point Divisions: All classes that count for a particular High Point Division are listed in the Show Premium and are posted on the window of the Show Office. To be eligible for the High Point, you must show the required number of classes in that division to qualify. The number of classes required are listed with a (*) under each division. Your High Point Division needs to be declared when registering for the show. If you have questions about your declaration, please go to the Show Office.

Errors: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the Show Office immediately if there is a suspected error.
