GENERAL RULES:

1. Open to any Pinto with visible color (NO BREEDING STOCK) registered with the Pinto Horse Association of America. Copy of registration papers must accompany entry.
2. Payment shall be in US Funds only.
3. All entries in the futurities must also enter at least one class in the regular show.
4. Entry must be made prior to the start of the first corresponding regular class (ie: a western pleasure futurity horse must enter the futurity before competition in any regular western pleasure class).
5. Entry does not include show fees, drug fees, stall fee, etc.
6. Substitution of horses is allowed with a vet certificate to remove original horse. Substitute horse must be the same owner as the original. An office fee equal to 10% of the original entry will be assessed.
7. Entry monies will only be refunded upon the death of the entered pinto. A certified veterinarian death certificate

must be mailed to the Futurity Chair within 30 days of death for refund. Office fees of 10% will be retained.

8. Nominations may be transferred upon sale of a nominated horse. The notice of sale and request for transfer must be received in writing before the horse is shown. A \$5.00 transfer fee must accompany each application.

9. A multiple judging system will be used for halter and performance. A tie-breaker judge will be designated. In the case of a tie, whichever Pinto the tie-breaker judge placed higher, will win the higher award. The monies for those places will be added together and divided equally among those that are tied. No exceptions to this rule.

10. All Pintos may be asked to submit to laboratory testing. All results will be completed before monies are paid. Any owner/handler refusing to submit a Pinto to testing will be disqualified with forfeiture of all awards. Any Pinto showing a positive lab test will be disqualified, with forfeiture of winnings.

11. A futurity entrant shall not be allowed to abuse or mistreat a horse in any manner on the show grounds. Such action shall be reported to the Futurity Committee and will be subject to disciplinary action by that committee or disqualification.

12. The decision to combine classes, when a class has less than 3 entries, lies solely with the show committee. Cancellation of classes will be the decision of the Futurity Committee.

13. In no event shall OPtHA, its officers, directors, agents or members be liable for actual, consequential or exemplary damages or for injury or damages to persons or property that may occur at any OPtHA event. By making entry into any OPtHA events, any owner or exhibitor assumes the full risk of any injury or damage which may occur and agrees to abide by all OPtHA rules and regulations.

14. All Pintos will be judged according to applicable Snaffle Bit, Driving or Halter class rules in the Official PtHA Handbook.

15. Bridles will be dropped in all futurities. Bits must conform to PtHA official Snaffle Bit or Driving Bit rules.

16. If a horse's mouth shows signs of broken skin, rawness or bleeding, the horse will be eliminated from competition. If a horse's nose or any other area touched by bosal shows signs of broken skin, rawness or bleeding, the horse will be eliminated from competition.

17. Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. In the case of a tie, a tie-breaker judge will be used. This judge shall be selected before the start of classes and his/her identity shall be held secret until all classes have been judged. In the case of a tie, the tiebreaker's placement will determine placement for ribbon/trophy awards only. Mooney due each placement will be combined and divided between the tied entries. All Pintos in a class will be placed by all judges. For example, in a class of 15, Pintos would be marked through 15th place.

18. Futurity checks will be mailed within 30 days. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING THE FUTURITY CHAIR, IN WRITING, OF ANY ADDRESS CHANGE.

19. Protests must be filed within 12 hours of the Championship announcement. Protest must be in writing and must be signed. There will be a non-refundable \$100.00 fee for each protest filed. This fee must accompany the protest. All protests which concern the futurity will be decided by both the show committee and the futurity committee.
